



Wildflowers Scarf

a narrow scarf with a textured cable fabric stitch pattern, by Ellen Bales

Posted on November 10, 2006

Yarn: 2-3 skeins (depending on desired length), Manos del Uruguay, Wildflowers colorway. My scarf consumed almost all of 2 skeins.

Needles: 1 pair, U.S. Size 7; 1 cable needle

Special abbreviations:

C4B (cable 4 back): slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2 sts from left-hand needle, then knit sts from cable needle.

C4F (cable 4 front): slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at or front of work, knit next 2 sts from left-hand needle, then knit sts from cable needle.

Pattern:

Cast on 22 stitches. Knit 3 rows.

Begin cable fabric.

Row 1: K

Row 2: K2, P18, K2.

Row 3: K2, *K2, C4B*, repeat between asterisks twice, K2.

Row 4: K2, P18, K2.

Row 5: K

Row 6: K2, P18, K2.

Row 7: K2, *C4F, K2*, repeat between asterisks twice, K2.

Row 8: K2, P18, K2.

Repeat these 8 rows until scarf is desired length, ending with Row 4 of cable fabric pattern.

Knit 3 rows.

Cast off.

Finishing: Thankfully, very little. Block if desired.
